

■ What's a Leaked Video?

without the person's consent.

It can happen through:

- Hacking
- Betrayal of trust
- Secret or unauthorized recording
- Screen capture or re-uploading private material

⚠ These aren't just "viral clips" — they are serious violations of privacy.

J The Social Media Ripple Effect

When you like $\ensuremath{\mbox{$\checkmark$}}$, comment $\ensuremath{\mbox{$\varsigma$}}$, or share $\ensuremath{\mbox{$\varsigma$}}$ a leaked video on social media, you're not just "joining the trend" — you're **amplifying harm**. The consequences for the victim can be devastating:

- Emotional trauma and mental health struggles
- Career, family, and reputation damage
- ▼ Harassment, bullying, or blackmail
- Lasting shame and public judgment

Every view ••, like •, and share share makes the harm worse.

Pause Before You Post

Before you watch, share, or comment on a viral or leaked video, ask yourself:

- Did the person choose to make this public?
- Is it ethical to view or spread this?
- Would I want my private moment shared like this?

If the answer is "no" — scroll past . Don't click . Don't engage X.

How to Create a Safer Social Media Space

✓ Don't share or react to leaked/private videos — even in "private" DMs or group chats

- Report the video and the account posting it
- Call out harmful behavior in comment sections
- Support those affected with empathy 💙, not judgment
- Use your platform () to educate others about consent and online safety

Privacy is a Right, Not a Trend

Fame, scandal, or public status do not erase a person's right to dignity. Everyone — whether famous or not — deserves control over their image, body, and voice.

Let's stop treating leaked videos as entertainment or gossip.
